

Old Salt Fishing Foundtion's King of the Beach Festival and Tournament will observe safe social distancing and provide enhanced hygiene and safety precautions for all anglers and spectators in attendance at the event.

We ask that all anglers and spectators please read and adhere to the following procedures below before your arrival at the King of the Beach.

- Please self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 and conduct a [CDC Coronavirus Self-Checker](#) **BEFORE** your arrival at the event. Anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms will not be permitted to enter the event.
- Please note masks or facial coverings are **REQUIRED** to be worn at all times during the event – in tents and outside. “No Mask, No Entry.”
- Masks must be worn when engaging with any vendor, including food and drink vendors.
- Masks can **ONLY** be removed when “actively” consuming food or drinks.
- All vendors and volunteers will be required to wear masks at all times.
- Sanitizer Stations will be available throughout the footprint.
- Hand washing stations will be place by the portable toilets.
- Signage regarding the required use of masks will be posted around the festival footprint.
- **PLEASE LEAVE PETS AT HOME!** Pets present issues with social distancing (e.g. petting brings attendees closer than the recommended safe distance, leashes get tangled and bring attendees closer than the recommended safe distance, etc.). We want everyone to stay safe (both our furry friends, and our human friends)! **Thank you for your cooperation!**
- Social Distancing Throughout the Event Footprint
- Volunteers will be roaming the event footprint to help maintain social distancing, and to remind attendees that masks **MUST** be worn at all times, unless *\*actively\** consuming food & drink only

### Social Distancing

Our event field at the Madeira Beach Recreation Complex has 3 points of entry. The main gate, the water entrance and an emergency exit will all be staffed with volunteers to check for masks and keep count of attendees. Our event field is rated for 7,500 total – we have reduced our vendors by 50% to allow more room for social distancing. We also plan to reduce attendance at any one time to 3,500 which is less than half capacity.

### Line Queuing

Entrances will have lines on ground 6 feet apart to help maintain social distancing. Volunteers enforcing the entrances will wear a mask at all times and have hand sanitizing stations in reach.

## Implementation and Enforcement

Staff/Volunteers will be required to attend the volunteer training meeting prior to the event. We will go over all the requirements with handouts to ensure proper implementation will be adhered to. This handout will also tell them to frequently wash hands with soap and water, especially if they handle money or going to the bathroom. The volunteers are instructed to go to the volunteer tent and report if they or attendees become unwell during the event. We will at this time ask them for their contact information and ask them to leave the event.

Any attendee not adhering to our COVID policies will be asked to leave the event.

Vendors will receive in their setup packages all the requirements for COVID safety and enforcement to ensure their education on procedures.

## Signage and Communication

Signs will be posted at the entry points and bathroom facilities that will have the requirements for mandatory masks and social distancing. Signs will also be placed throughout the footprint with these requirements.

Our website will have the COVID safety requirements posted online and emailed to all our anglers/teams fishing.

## Sanitation & Disinfection

We have hired a team to maintain sanitation and disinfection. They will walk around to all areas and clean/wipe off surfaces. We will have one as the bathroom attendant – Lysol each stall after use, make sure hand sanitizer and wash stations are disinfected hourly.

They will have ample stock at our storage trailer of supplies including Lysol spray and wipes, Bleach water spray bottles and clean towels.

Signage will be up in the volunteer area to remind them to wash hands or use hand sanitizer frequently.

Cashless payments will be recommended for use to all the vendors. Our stations will offer both cashless and cash payments. The stations will have hand sanitizer and Lysol wipes to clean them in between uses.
